

The Mine

Miraculite™ Minerals is mined from a unique deposit of Calcium Montmorillinite, a type of clay renowned for its nutritional and medicinal properties for millions of years. This particular deposit of clay is hidden deep within the Sierra Nevada mountain range in a pristine wilderness area over 6,000 feet above sea level.
